This year at Courthill we will mark Remembrance Day by holding a minute's silence in school on Monday 11th November. We look forward to creating our annual 'poppy field' display across the front of our school by decorating the windows with poppies made by the children. This is a lovely way of allowing our whole school community to enjoy all the beautiful, creative poppies and help commemorate this special day of remembrance together.

We are asking the children to make poppies as part of their home learning (please see Autumn 2 home learning grid). They can be decorated however you like – for example, you could use colouring pencils, felt tips, glitter, collage or paint. We ask that the poppies be no bigger than A4.
