At Courthill Infant school we enjoy following the Bournemouth and Poole agreed syllabus for RE, DiscoveryRE. It is an enquired based approach to learning and each scheme of work gives the children the opportunity to consider a question, it progresses through to the end of Year 6. We help our children to develop skills of investigation, empathy, reflection, evaluation and attitudes of appreciation, curiosity, open mindedness and self-awareness.
