Dear Parents / Carers,

At Courthill we strive to support the different needs and learning styles of our children. We want to ensure that the children have access to opportunities that match their learning, social, physical and emotional needs.

We are therefore able to offer children a range of interventions to support them in areas where it has been identified by teachers that this extra provision would be beneficial.

We are fortunate to be able to offer a range of interventions including:

- Speech and Language (SALT) provision to support children's speech, language and understanding
- Emotional Literacy (ELSA) sessions to support children's social and emotional needs
- A Learn to Move, Move to Learn programme which supports the development of children's fine and gross motor skills, co-ordination and balance
- Sensory Circuits which are a form of sensory integration intervention. The circuits aim to facilitate sensory processing to help children regulate to achieve the optimum level of alertness required for effective learning
- Various specific interventions to support children's reading, writing and maths.

Children may work in or out of class with a member of staff during these interventions, either 1:1 or as a group. This additional support may be for a short period of time or may be ongoing depending on your child's needs. Your child's class teacher will discuss any need for additional support with you, but it should be seen as a part of your child's individualised learning experience at Courthill and not as a cause for concern.

Please also speak to your child's class teacher if you feel your child would benefit from any specific support strategies. The staff members responsible for the additional support sessions are:

- Learn to Move, Move to Learn – Coach Aaron
- Sensory Circuits – Coach Aaron
- ELSA – Mrs Worboys and Mrs Hird
- SALT - Mrs Larman, Mrs Stride and Mrs Richer

We also offer pastoral support with Mrs Worboys who is available Monday, Thursday and Friday mornings to meet with parents on an individual basis if the need arises. If you would like to make an appointment with Mrs Worboys, please ring the school office.
