Dear Parents / Carers

Please find enclosed your child's annual written report. We send this during the Spring Term so that children have immediate and ongoing opportunities to respond to advice and targets for the rest of this academic year. We have also enclosed a report of your child's attendance so far this year.

The report gives you a summary of your child's progress, attainment and attitude towards learning across the curriculum and their predicted grades for the end of the academic year. In Early Years (Reception) the grades are:

- **B:** working significantly below National level.
- **WT:** working towards National Level.
- **N:** working at National Level (age-related expectation).

In Key Stage 1 (Year 1 and Year 2), the attainment grades link directly to end of Key Stage expectations, so your child will be identified as one of the following:

- **B:** working significantly below the expected standard. This is typically for a small number of children who may have special educational needs that impact their ability to meet the expected standards in certain subject areas.
- **WT:** working towards the expected standard. Children will receive additional support to boost progress. Please ask the teacher if there are additional activities you can support with at home.
- **ARE:** working at the expected standard (Age Related Expectation).
- **GD:** working at a Greater Depth and exceeding the age-related expectation.

At the end of the academic year, we will hold parent teacher consultations and you will receive a final summary of your child's attainment and progress for the year, as well as information about ways to help them to further develop. In the meantime, please feel free to contact your child's class teacher if you would like to discuss your child's report in more detail.

We would really appreciate your feedback about your child's report. Please look out for an email, which we will send in few days / weeks. It will include a short online form; an opportunity to share your views about your child's report and share additional comments related to your child's learning.
