Dear Parents / Carers

We are excited to be arranging a visit to Beaulieu Motor Museum for our Year 1 children on **Tuesday 30th June**. This will be a fun and educational day where the children will learn all about the history of transport and will consolidate what they have learned in school during their Summer 2 topic 'Wheels, Wings and Other Things'.

To make the most of the day, it's essential that all children arrive at school promptly at the normal time of 8.35am-8.50am, as the coaches will be collecting us at **9am**. Unfortunately, late arrivals may risk missing the trip, so your support in getting your child to school on time is greatly appreciated. We expect to return by 3pm, but please collect your child at the slightly later time of **3.15 pm**. This allows the children time to return to their classroom and be dismissed safely from their usual pick-up point.

Your child should wear school uniform and comfortable shoes for walking. Children should have a sun hat with them and a waterproof coat (even if it is sunny in the morning!). Please also apply long-lasting sun cream on your child before they leave home. Children should come to school with a backpack (clearly named), so they can carry their belongings around during the visit.

If your child already has a hot school meal booked via the Chartwells portal, this meal will automatically be converted to a vegetarian packed lunch. If you do not have a meal ordered, please can you provide a packed lunch from home (no nuts please). Sorry but medical diet meals cannot be converted, so please provide a packed lunch from home if this affects your child. Please also include your child's usual water bottle. There is no need to pack extra drinks on this day as there will be water refill points at Beaulieu.

The cost of the trip, which includes transport and the entrance fee for Beaulieu Motor Museum, is **£17.30 per child**. On this occasion, we have been able to heavily subsidise the cost of the trip, in an attempt to make it more affordable – we hope this will help parents / carers. Please **log in to Arbor to give consent for your child** to attend the trip and make payment. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you are concerned about meeting the cost. If your child has a medical condition, which the school is not already aware of, please inform the class teacher.

Our visits are very popular and they would be impossible without your help, so if you would like to volunteer for the day, please complete the online 'volunteer' form by Friday 22nd May ([click here for link](#)). Please note, names will be drawn from a hat if we are oversubscribed with offers of helpers.
