We are offering FREE bike safety checks

We will carry out basic bike checks and minor adjustments, including tyre inflation, bolt tightening, gear tuning, and simple repairs such as replacing inner tubes, brake pads, or cables. Broken accessories may be removed if needed. Checks take place throughout the day, with advice provided on any further work required to help keep bikes safe to ride.

How to take part:

- ✓ Sign up by 1st November using the **QR code** (limited places - the sign up will close once places are filled)
- ✓ Ride your bike to school on 4th November
- ✓ Leave it **unlocked**



We'll check as many bikes as we can, prioritising those who've signed up before the day.

Let's keep your bikes safe and ready to ride!
